

The Warren Memorial Scholarship

Application

The scholarship application period begins March 1 and ends April 30 each year.

Applicants must submit the following:

- Completed scholarship application
- Sealed official copy of school transcript
- Résumé (as explained within the application)
- Recent, small, color photo

Criteria

Applicants must comply with the following requirements to be considered eligible to receive a college scholarship:

- Must have attended Warren Memorial United Methodist Church for at least two years
- Must be actively involved in church activities
- Should contribute to the church financially or through service
- Must have a high school grade point average of at least 2.5

Applicants also will be judged on other criteria, such as:

- Leadership activities
- Service outside the church
- Citizenship

Applicants may or may not be required to appear before the Warren Scholarship Committee for an oral interview.

Recipients

Recipients must:

- Provide proof of registration as full-time students in a regular academic program of two or more years. The scholarship check then will be made payable either to the recipient or his/her institution of enrollment.
- Submit a receipt or similar documentation to verify that they used the scholarship for college expenses. Such documentation keeps the scholarships in compliance with IRS regulations.
